# **Music Composition Portfolio**

I have a growing compositional portfolio, using my performance skills on piano (Grade 8), violin and percussion and key understanding of orchestration and arrangement for different ensembles to create bespoke music.

My enrolment on a course for Composing for Film, TV & Games at the National Film and Television School this September will enhance my compositional skill set with specific media understanding, to enable me to take on more demanding and increasingly varied projects.

I am always interested in discovering and experimenting with new and different sound worlds, including diverse world music styles, to push the limits of my creativity.

Previous colleagues have endorsed my professional communication and quality of work.

- "Espionage Worldwide", which draws on a wide range of ethnomusicological influences from China, Spain and Africa.
- "Othello" was a theatre production I directed, composed and conducted the music for in 2018, writing a large volume of music, including 20th century swing and a solo lament which was praised by a local newspaper for its 'aching beauty'.
- "The Argonauts" was a short storytelling musical work performed by the Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra's Kokoro ensemble at a local festival in 2016.
- "Game On" is a podcast series interviewing famous sports personalities which I wrote the upbeat and energetic themes for.
- "Trials of Reincarnation" was a superhero film soundtrack combining wacky jazz themes with darker tones to portray a juxtaposition of heroism with comedy.

### **Achievements and Interests**

**Film:** I love both watching and making films, so I have got involved with the university InFilm Society as a Boom Mic/Sound Operator to improve my production skills, connections and knowledge of the industry.

**Music:** I have achieved my Grade 8 Piano Merit through dedication to practice and perseverance. I also sing bass and play violin to a high standard in a variety of university societies, often taking a leadership role in these situations too, notably as Conductor for the Galenical Chamber Orchestra and Orchestral Manager for the Bristol Symphonia Philharmonic. I have also used my musical knowledge as an opportunity to teach and accompany other students for their concerts and examinations.

**Volunteering, Fundraising and Events Management**: I'm very organised and self-motivated and I used these skills to help transform student experiences for the better, such as through my charity work and negotiations on behalf of students as Head Boy.
